He will continue his relationship with the Company by focusing on introducing CityView to the mainland Chinese market. Tsang has also resigned his position as Corporate Secretary.

Director Foo and the Board will now begin an aggressive search for a new Board member with broad management experience. At the moment the Board consists of Mel Couvelier, Chairman; Robert Bennett, President and CEO; Troy Kusy, Vice President, Norm Cafik and Robert Foo.
