The City of Keene, New Hampshire to use CityView® for its E-City Project

Municipal Software Corporation, a leading developer of local government business process automation software and a wholly owned subsidiary of Municipal Solutions Group, Inc. (TSX: MSM), announced today that the City of Keene, NH expanded their CityView® 8.NET Enterprise system in order to create an E-city portal.

The E-City portal project is designed to offer services on-line to the city's constituents. Such services include online bill payment and online registration and licensing. Rebecca Landry, the Director of Information Management Services for the city said, "The idea is to make city services available around the clock and without having to come into City Hall to do it. And that means paying bills, registering for programs and applying for permits. CityView 8.NET Enterprise not only makes this possible, it makes it a seamless extension of our internal systems."

The City of Keene already uses CityView to automate a wide range of its business processes. The City began by automating its Voter Registration activities, just prior to the 1999 November primaries. The Voter Registration system was used successfully in the presidential primaries and has been used in local government elections since then. Municipal Software Corporation won a Best Solutions Award at the Government Technology Conference in May 2002 for this Voter Registration system. Keene has since expanded its use of CityView to include Building and Code Enforcement, Cemetery Management, Youth Services and Animal Licensing.

According to Landry, "We have found that there are many municipal information tracking needs for which there are no robust applications available in today's market. We have chosen CityView as the one application that can meet all of these needs without adding a multitude of independent applications to our network, keeping our support and maintenance resource requirements to a minimum while still meeting all of our end users' needs."

Rob Bennett, President of Municipal Software commented, "It is great to see the City of Keene expand their use of CityView to the Web. We are excited about their use of our new CityView 8.NET innovations and look forward to seeing the results of their E-City portal project. We are proud of their confidence in our product, the fact that we continue to meet expectations for additional systems on an increasingly more enterprise basis, and the strong relationship that has been built between our organizations."

CityView 8.NET Enterprise also incorporates ESRI's MapObjects to allow direct links to mapping data so users can deploy maps with their Web forms and reports by using ESRI's ArcIMS. CityView 8.NET Enterprise automatically completes the entire configuration necessary to make this work.

The City of Keene, population 25,000, is located in the beautiful Monadnock Region in Cheshire County. It has been described as the Currier and Ives corner of New Hampshire. It is known for its vibrant downtown and woodland trails and was selected by *Parenting Magazine* as one of "10 Great Places to Raise a Family."
