Municipal Software Corporation Posts Q3 Results For 2002

VICTORIA—Municipal Software Corporation, a leading developer of local government business process automation software and a wholly owned subsidiary of Municipal Solutions Group, Inc. (TSX: MSM), today announced third quarter financial results for the three-month period ending September 30, 2002.

Revenue rose to \$1,041,185, an increase of 12% over the revenue booked last year of \$932,487 during the same period. Expenses rose to \$1,013,141, an 18% increase from \$858,027 spent during Q3 in 2001. This yielded a third quarter profit of \$28,044, which compares to the profit recorded during the same period last year of \$74,460.

After the first nine months of 2002, the company recorded year-to-date revenues of \$2,804,595, expenses of \$2,755,840 and profit of \$48,755.

While the company's 2002 revenues are expected to grow 35% compared to 2001, revenues in Q4 will be short of previous forecasts, due strictly to timing of contract finalizations. Revenues in Q4 are forecast to be \$1,400,000, expenses are forecast to be \$1,050,000, and profitability is forecast to be \$350,000. The year-to-date profit forecast is set at \$398,000, comparing favorably to last year's profit of \$361,061.

All financial results were prepared internally using Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) and are expressed in Canadian dollars.
